



Uniform Policy

Romero Academies requires all scholars wear a uniform, as outlined below, every day of the school year, unless otherwise noted. The school uniform policy assists in instilling a sense of personal pride in scholars and maintaining a consistent and focused learning environment.

Each child must wear a polo shirt and pants, shorts, skirts, or jumpers daily. Please see below for additional information.

- **Polo Shirt:** black, royal blue, white
- **Pants and shorts (knee-length):** black, khaki
 - Leggings are not permitted to be worn as pants, they must be covered by a jumper or skirt.
 - Jeans and denim are not allowed.
- **Jumpers and skirts (Optional):** black, khaki
- **Jackets and Sweatshirts (Optional):** Plain solid black, royal blue, or white sweatshirt, sweater, or fleece zip up.
 - No hooded sweatshirts will be permitted to be worn inside the classrooms.
 - Scholars may **not** wear jackets or coats inside the school classroom/building.
- **Shoes:** Any laced, close-toed shoe.
 - Students must be in close-toed shoes with the entire foot concealed.
 - Sandals, crocs, boots, clogs, and shoes that light up are not permitted.



The teacher or principal will inform parents of children who do not comply with the policy. The steps that will be taken are identified below. Some infractions will necessitate that the parent/guardian is called to make arrangements to ensure that parents and students are compliant with school expectations.

2: Impactful to Learning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Shirt that is not a polo ● Ripped pants or shorts ● Shorts or skirts that are not approved length. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Parent receives phone call and must bring appropriate clothing or make other arrangements with school administration ● Larger consequence is given (loss of lunch, loss of recess, detention, etc.)

- **Purses:** Scholars are not allowed to wear purses unless they carry an inhaler or have another medical need to do so. The inhaler must be carried in the clear purse provided by the school.
- **Hats:** Scholars are not allowed to wear hats, scarves, headbands, or bandanas in the classroom/building. Small hair clips or hair bands are permitted.

If there is a question concerning the uniform, the principal will make the final decision. All clothing worn should be clean and be the appropriate size and fit. The student's undergarments should be covered at all times and should not be overtly visible.
